

CANOE POLO PLAYERS + SKILLS SESSION POOL USERS

- Please be respectful and courteous to everyone including canoe polo players, skills sessions users, Leisure Centre staff and members of the public
- Safety for all is a priority - you use this facility and equipment entirely at your own risk. Any injury to yourself or any other must be reported to a member of the LCC committee and/or member of Leisure Centre staff on duty.
- Please be aware that canoes can cause significant damage to the swimming pool (eg cracked tiles etc) resulting in potential danger to other users, unnecessary expense and possible closure of the pool - please report any damage to Leisure Centre staff on duty.
- Take care when removing and replacing equipment to avoid unnecessary damage - please treat all equipment as if it were your own!
- At the end of either polo or skills session, please help to replace equipment in an orderly and organised way.
- Report any damage of kayaks to a member of the committee in attendance or to the Equipment Officer.
- Canoes may be loaned with prior agreement from LCC committee member or the Equipment Officer - the lender is entirely responsible for the security of the kayaks and will be held liable for any damage, loss or theft. They may only be used at indoor facilities (ie swimming pools) to safeguard against biocontamination.
- If you bring your own boat to a pool session, it must be free of grit and dirt and thoroughly cleaned inside and out.
